**All swimmers returning for the fall/winter season will again be expected to register by mail this year.** Registration forms for the fall/winter season will be mailed to all SSC-registered swimmers in early August and must be timely returned by mail by the August 31<sup>st</sup> deadline. A \$50 late fee will be imposed for late registrations by returning swimmers. There will be no walk-in registration for returning swimmers. Fall/winter practices will begin the week of September 12<sup>th</sup>. Please check the SSC website in early September for more details regarding the fall/winter season practice schedule and start dates.

**Meet Program Advertising Forms** for SSC-hosted meets during the fall/winter season will be e-mailed to SSC families shortly. SSC families are asked to solicit ads from local businesses or place personal ads of support that will appear in the meet programs for the 5 meets that SSC will host during the coming season. For each ad that an SSC family secures, they will receive a credit towards future registration fees equal to 50% of the amount of advertising they bring to the Club. Ads must be turned in by mid-October in order to appear in the Trick or Treat Meet program, which is the first meet that SSC will host this fall.
